Earn Certification

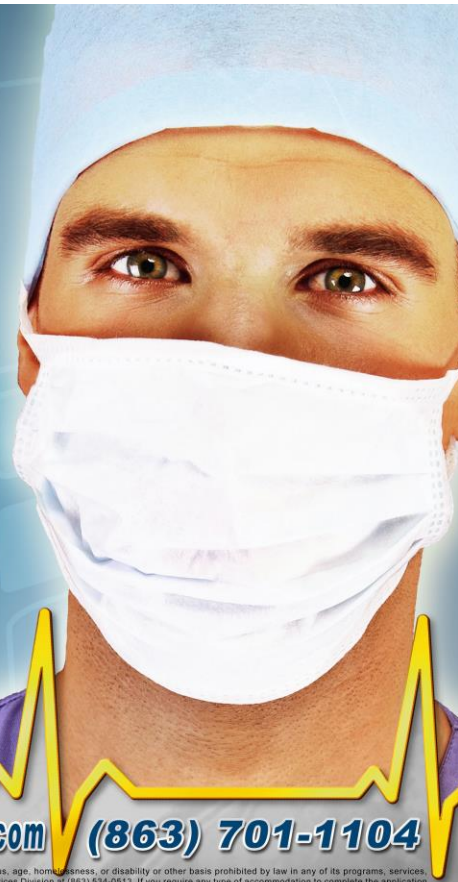
